## Bank of Sun Prairie steamrolls to Team Racquetball title

A turnaround for the ages propelled the Bank of Sun Prairie to the 2009-10 Prairie Athletic Club Team Racquetball title.

The Bank of Sun Prairie started the season with only three wins in its first 10 matches, but finished the season with nine straight wins – including three impressive victories in the playoffs.

Facing first-half champs Realty 2.0, the Bank of Sun Prairie got points from all six of its players in a 16-5 win to start the day. Next up was top seed Ginger Bread House Preschool and this time five players scored in a 13-7 victory.

The championship was a battle of attrition as both teams were playing their third match in about five hours. The Bank of Sun Prairie again got points from five of its players in a 13-6 win for the title.

Jason Pierner and Dwayne Scherneck led the way, each going 3-0 on the day. Dave Travis went 2-0, Jason Smith went 2-1, Kris Allen won his only match, while Jeff Hogg and Paul Krueger each won a match.

Madison Street Pub, making its third straight trip to the Team Racquetball title match, advanced to the final with two incredibly close wins. In the quarters, team captain Jesi Haak rallied to win the last match in an 11-10 tiebreaker, which tied the team score at 10-10 before Madison Street Pub topped Badger Graphics on the strength of total points, 171-150. Haak again rallied to win an 11-10 tiebreaker to push her squad to a 12-8 victory over Door Creek Financial in the semis. Dave Glusick went 3-0 to lead the team, while Jesi and Jim Haak each went 2-1.

Door Creek Financial advanced to the semis in another tiebreaker match, defeating Think! Toner & Ink, 10-10 and 171-155 in total points.

Tracy Chynoweth ended the year 16-0 in the No. 1 spot, while Glusick went 13-2 and Krueger was 12-5. Travis had the best record (9-3) at the No. 2 spot with Allen right behind at 5-1. John Shanks (Realty 2.0) ended the year 13-3 at the No. 3 spot, while Mike Martin (Service Specialists) was 8-3.

Ginger Bread House Preschool (Jeff Nehmer, 10-1 and Nick Uebelacker, 8-3) and Badger Graphics (Becky Denniston, 11-2 and Lorraine Krueger 6-0) dominated the No. 4 spot. Mark Schneider (Door Creek Financial, 11-1), Matt Uebelacker (Hummer's Hideout, 10-3) and Amy Miller (12-5, Madison Street Pub) were the top players at the No. 5 spot. Scherneck finished 12-2 playing both the No. 5 and 6 spots, while Dan Young (Think! Toner & Ink, 5-0) and Pam Haffely (Hummer's Hideout, 6-2) were strong players at the No. 6 spot.
