

## Chynoweth repeats PAC title

In another display of speed, shot-making ability and consistency, Tracy Chynoweth rolled to his second straight Mens Open championship at the 2009 Prairie Athletic Club (PAC) Singles Racquetball Tournament, sponsored by Calkins Engineering.

Chynoweth matched up with 2007 champ Jamie Arnold in the final, which was eerily similar to the 2008 title match. As in 2008, Chynoweth came out firing, winning the first game with ease before Arnold stepped up his game to dominate game two. Chynoweth then took control late, scoring the last six points to win the tiebreaker, 11-5.

Chynoweth took out up-and-coming Brad Falvey in the semis after stopping Brad Chitko in the quarters. Arnold went tiebreaker in both of his opening matches, stopping Pete Simon in the quarters and beating four-time club champ Paul Krueger for the third straight year in the semis.

Chynoweth also topped Arnold in the 35+Open final and teamed with Tracie Studinski to beat Dave Rajkovich and Tina Schoewe in the Mixed Open final.

Becky Denniston repeated her championship in Womens Open – winning her third overall womens title – by taking out her doubles partner Jesi Haak in a tiebreaker.

Alex Korenic had a fantastic tourney, winning both the Mens AA and Mens A titles. The juniors divisions offered up some great competition as Jacob Ford got past Connor Blake in the 1-bounce division, while Andrew Cassidy held off Ashley Tubbs to win the 2-bounce division.

A total of 108 players competed in the tourney, which featured 19 divisions and was also sponsored by Jimmy John's Subs, Chipotle Mexican Grille, JB's Italian Grille and Wisconsin Distributors. Results of the tournament are listed below.
